- ★ **International Academy of Trenton Charter School (K-6)** students will show mastery of a rigorous, international, college-preparatory curriculum delivered through proven, research-based instruction.
- ★ **International Charter School of Trenton (K-4)** is a small, tight-knit school community that was created to provide a quality elementary education for Trenton City residents.
- ★ **Pace Charter School of Hamilton (K-6)** instills a lifelong love of learning in its students. Pace was recently named a Blue Ribbon School for Academic Excellence.
- ★ **Paul Robeson Charter School for the Humanities (4-8)** offers a rigorous college-prep curriculum where students are provided double reading and double math time to ensure they are prepared for the best high schools and colleges.
- ★ **Trenton STEM-to-Civics Charter School (9-12)** mission is to use STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) to inspire academic excellence, to promote civic engagement, and to ensure students are ready for college and career.
- ★ **The Village Charter School (K-8)** mission is to create a child-centered community of active learners where each child will succeed in ways that reflect his or her own unique aptitudes and interests. We unite parents, teachers and the community in the common pursuit of excellence.

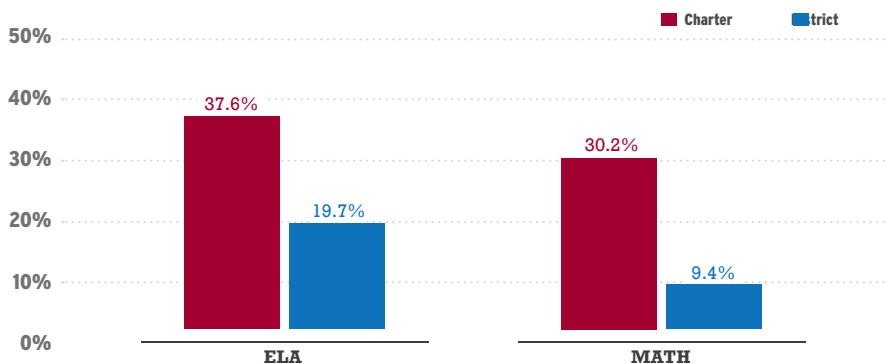
