CCSN schools focus on foundational skills, character education, a rigorous college-prep curriculum, and strong partnerships between the school, family, and the community.
- ★ Environment Community Opportunity (ECO) Charter School (K-6) ensures that all students develop strong roots, achieving excellence through rigor, relevance, and reflection. ECO nurtures students to become adept learners, community leaders, and environmental stewards.
- ★ Freedom Prep Charter School (K-12), part of the Democracy Prep charter school network, seeks to educate responsible citizen-scholars for success in

- Hope Community Charter School (K-4) provides a safe, caring, literacy rich learning environment for our students. Hope believes a whole school focus on language acquisition and development can transform a child's life.
- LEAP Academy Charter School (K-12) utilizes a rigorous college-preparatory STEM curriculum to ensure students are ready to meet the challenges of the 21st Century. As a holistic community school, LEAP also provides services (early childhood education, physical therapy, mental health counseling, medical support, and health and wellness) to its families from birth through adulthood.






