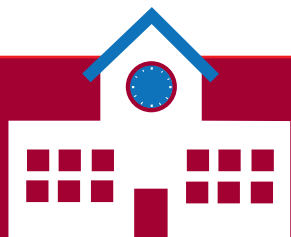
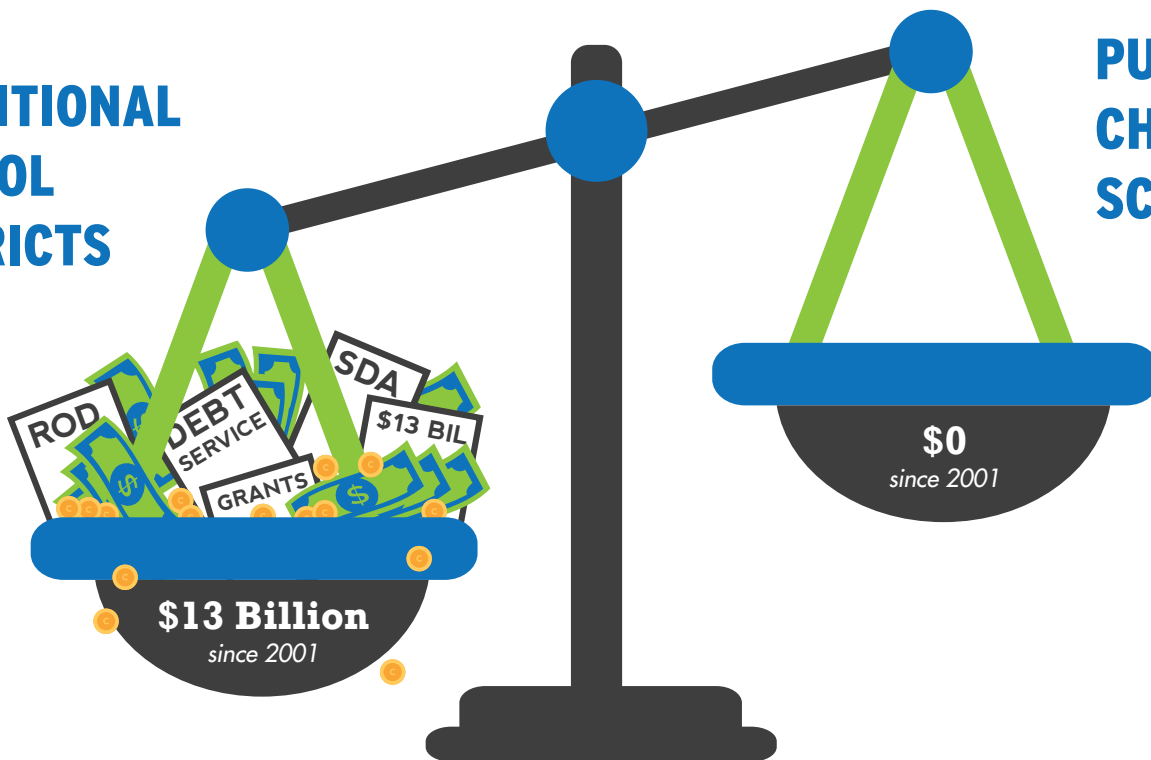




## SCHOOL FACILITIES FUNDING INEQUITY

Public charter schools statewide currently receive \$0 for facilities funding. On average, **PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS SPEND \$1,500 PER PUPIL ON FACILITIES COSTS**, all out of their operating budgets.

Since 2001, the state has spent nearly \$13 billion on public school facilities in 555 school districts in New Jersey with **\$0 GOING TO PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITY PROJECTS.**
